**Local Public Authority Name:** Suffolk County Industrial Development Agency (SCIDA)

**Fiscal Year:** January 1, 2015 – December 31, 2015

**Enabling Legislation** (enables Local Public Authority Mission Statement): Industrial Development Agencies (“IDAs”) are formed under Article 18-A of New York State General Municipal Law, as public benefit corporations. IDAs were created to actively promote, encourage, attract and develop job and recreational opportunities and economically-sound commerce and industry in cities, towns, villages and counties throughout New York State (the “State”). IDAs are empowered to provide financial assistance to private entities through tax incentives in order to promote the economic welfare, prosperity and recreational opportunities for residents of a municipality (“Benefited Municipality”).

**Mission Statement:** SCIDA mission is to promote the economic welfare, employment opportunities and quality of life of the residents of Suffolk County. SCIDA accomplishes this mission by providing financial assistance to businesses in order to help them flourish and grow in Suffolk County.

**2015 Measurements and Goals:**

1. Secure new capital investment of \$100 million during 2015.
2. Secure the retention and/or creation of 500 jobs during 2015.
3. Continue to expand and strengthen existing regional partnerships through various organizations and activities.
4. Continue to participate in regional economic development initiatives and activities such as the Long Island Regional Economic Development Council.
